RIBBONS and AWARDS:

The following awards are offered by the Mid-Florida Golden Retriever Club. A qualifying score is required for all awards in regular classes. Awards must be picked up in person or by a designated representative on the day of the Trial. No awards will be mailed. Unclaimed awards become the property of MFGRC, MFGRC reserves the right to substitute an award of equal value. All awards for the all-breed will be offered as well as the specialty awards.

Awards for competition within a single regular Obedience class, Alternate Titling class, and Rally class will be presented only to dogs placing 1st through 4th. Golden Retrievers earning 1st–4th place will receive the same all-breed placement awards and will also be recognized for Golden Retriever specialty awards.

Qualifying ribbons are given to all exhibitors that have a score of 170 or higher in Obedience and a score of 70 or higher in Rally.

OBEDIENCE and RALLY CLASS AWARDS:

AWARDS will be awarded after the completion of the classes involved and must be picked up on the same day as the trial.

Braided leather training leash by HMI will be offered exclusively for the four awards listed below and will be presented in addition to the designated rosette, or a prize of equal value.

Highest Scoring Golden Retriever: Obedience Regular Class (HIT) - Blue & Gold Rosette

Highest Combined Score Golden Retriever: Obedience Open B & Utility B (HC) - Blue & Green Rosette

Highest Combined Score Golden Retriever: Rally Advance B /Excellent B Class (HC) - Blue & Green Rosette

Highest Triple Qualifying Golden Retriever: Advance B/Excellent B/Master (HTQ) - Blue & Red Rosette

NON-REGULAR OBEDIENCE:

1st Place Rose 2nd Place Brown 3rd Place Light Green 4th Place Gray

Note: Dog means either sex. Entries in non-regular classes are only eligible for non-regular class awards.

Regular Class entries, including the UDX, RAE and RACH classes, will be given first priority followed by the Optional Titling Classes followed by the Non-Regular Classes.

UDX Class - When entries are limited in the Open B and /or Utility B classes, a club must designate a UDX class in the premium list. Dogs entered in this UDX class would be entered in both Open B and Utility B, and the combined entry fee for these two classes must be paid. Once the limit has been reached in either the Open B or the Utility B class, the UDX class will be considered closed and any subsequent entries for this class will be unacceptable in their entirety.

RAE and RACH Class When entries are limited, a club must designate an RAE

and a Rally Champion (RACH) class in the premium list. Dogs entered in the RAE class would be entered in both Advanced B and Excellent B, and the combined entry fee for these two classes must be paid. If due to entry limits an exhibitor cannot be entered in both the Advanced B and Excellent B classes, the RAE class will be considered closed and any subsequent entries for this class will be unacceptable in their entirety. Dogs entered in the RACH class would be entered in Advanced B, Excellent B and the Master class. The combined entry fee for these three classes must be paid. If due to entry limits an exhibitor cannot be entered in the Advanced B, Excellent B and Master classes the RACH class will be considered closed and any subsequent entries for this class will be unacceptable in their entirety.

NOTIC TO ALL EXHIBITORS:

CLOSING DATE for entries is Wednesday, July 22, 2026, after which time entries cannot be accepted, changed or cancelled except as allowed per move up clause below. Entries must be signed by owner or agent and submitted with fees.

No telephone or fax entries can be accepted. EXPRESS DELIVERY services must include SIGNATURE WAIVER permitting them to be left WITHOUT recipient's signature.

Returned Check: There will be a \$60.00 fee for any returned check

AKC Recording Fees: Entry fees include a \$4.50 Obedience/Rally Event fee for each entry at every club licensed. Non-Regular Classes are excluded. These fees are collected by the show-giving club and remitted to the American Kennel Club. (New AKC Rule effective January 1, 2026)

Entry fees will not be refunded in the event the dog is absent, disqualified, excused by a Judge or Veterinarian, or barred from competition by the Trial Committee. If because of riots, civil disturbances, unsafe weather conditions or other acts beyond the control of the Club it is impossible to open or to complete the Trial, no refund of entry fees will be made.

Transfers:

- After a dog earns a title, a transfer (i.e., from an obedience class to an obedience class or a rally class to a rally class) may be requested if, according to the owner's records, the handler and dog are eligible and the dog has completed the requirements for the title after the closing date of the trial in which the advanced entry is to be made.
- The request for a transfer must be in writing and presented to the trial secretary at least 30 minutes prior to the start of each trial.
- Transfers may be approved provided the class and judge are available, and the class has not reached its limit.

For a written request regarding a transfer for an ineligible dog and handler team from the "A" class to the "B" class at the same level, please refer to the AKC Obedience Regulations, Chapter 1, Section 16b

VACCINATIONS ETC. Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian's recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases and have appropriate vaccinations.

BITCHES that come into season after the closing date for entries may have the entry fee less \$5.00 per dog per class refunded upon written request of the owner or handler before the start of judging on the day of the trial.

ATTENTION ALL EXHIBITORS:

* Misconduct at hotels/motels may result in an Event Committee hearing. * Exhibitors are responsible for picking up after their dogs at the MFGRC/ODTC Training Building and at hotels/motels. Your continued responsibility and respect allow hotels / motels to continue to work with MFGRC/ODTC so we can provide you with the best venue possible. Please relieve your dogs in marked areas outside and be careful not to allow your dog to mark or urinate inside or on the buildings, trash cans and cars nearby. Trash cans are placed throughout the grounds-please use them. * The MFGRC/ODTC Training building is a smoke-free building. * Per AKC rules no dogs are allowed in the show rings for practice at any time. * Please bring your own chairs and crates. * Ex-pens are NOT permitted indoors at our trials because of building size limitations. * No dogs may be left in the building after 6:00 pm or overnight.

MFGRC/ODTC assumes no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors, handlers, visitors, children, dogs or property. The welfare of children is the responsibility of the parents or guardian. Parents or Guardians must exercise control and restraint over their children at all times. INSTRUCTIONS

1. (Variety) if you are entering a dog of breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering, i.e., Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, parti-color), Beagles (not exceeding 13 in., over 13 in. but not exceeding 15 in.), Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wirehaired), Collies (rough, smooth), Bull Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, standard).
2. (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e. A or B division.
3. A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his/her name. State on entry form whether transfer application has been mailed to the AKC. (For complete rules, refer to Chapter 11, Section 3.)
4. Dogs listed in the **AKC Canine PartnersSM Program** may be eligible to enter all-breed AKC Obedience trials at the club's option. These dogs should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC Number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box. Sire and Dam information shall remain blank for mixed breed entrants.

AGREEMENT
