

Can't swim, might as well sleep

The meeting, which was held at the Brick and Fire restaurant in South Orlando, was called to order by President Camille Doehring at 7:36 PM.

Board Members present were Tom Hell, Joanne Hell, Leah Wright, Shirl Phillips, Judi Volpe, Camille Doehring, Deena Strauss, Tammy Hodgkins, Debbie Finch, and Ted Crowell.

Vice President's report: Joanne Hell reported that there are no new applications.

Secretary's Report: Debbie advised that the minutes from the June 8th Board meeting have been e-mailed to everyone. A motion to waive reading of the minutes from the previous Board meeting was made by Judi Volpe, and seconded by Shirl Phillips.

Treasurer's Report: Tom Hell presented the Treasurer's Report. In the interest of the Club, we do not publish income information on the internet.

Committee Reports:

Agility Trial (October 13-14, 2012): Camille reported that Chair John Blair has advised that the premium list is on the club's website, and Trial Secretary Jill has sent the info out to other clubs to spread the word about the trial. Joanne Hell advised that IPOC in Lakeland hired "Two Men and a Truck" to help set up their recent agility trial, and it was considered an effective and cost efficient decision - something for us to consider.

Fall Hunt Test (Dec. 1-2, 2012): Tom Hell reported that a new boy scout troop has been suggested by Wayne Gey. Tom will follow-up on this. We are going to hold a combined dinner with CFHRC at Wayne's house, and it will be catered by Char-Don. The two clubs will split the dinner expenses, and will also buy ducks together. Wayne is going to order the ducks.

Spring Hunt Test (Feb. 9-10, 2013): Chair Mike Orloff has lined up a couple of judges, and is working on others. We discussed whether to add shot flyers to the Junior Hunter test; this would require more ducks and more gunners. No decision was made at this time.

Eastern Regional Specialty (Oct. 24-28, 2012): (1) Judi Volpe is going to touch base with Karen Brady and Julie Kielts to ask for their help with the Raffle. We discussed needing a letter to provide to potential donors for them to document their donation. Judi will work on this. (2) Shirl reported that she is working on getting dog food companies as sponsors; she is considering doing "levels" such as Platinum for a \$5000 donation. (3) Joanne advised that there is no update is available at this time from the hotel on food for the Saturday night party. (4) Tom is going to work on getting golf carts to use for the weekend. (5) Camille is working on getting a musician for the Saturday night event, and is open to suggestions as to who to hire. (6) We discussed having pop up tents at the bathing area; we are going to plan to use the Club's EZ Ups. (7) Deena confirmed that she will be able to tell prospective volunteers to steward for Obedience and Rally that they will be given lunch and a free raffle ticket. (8) A meeting of the event chairpersons to be held at the host hotel was discussed, and tentatively scheduled for August 18th. (9) Tom advised that thus far, we have spent approx. \$5,700 (for ads, decorations, tent deposit, website, and ordering merchandise), and thus far have collected \$1,197 of income for the Regional.

Old Business:

July and August general meetings: we discussed whether to open the July meeting with Nancy Withers to other breeds, and whether to charge for non-members. We decided to allow other breeds to attend, and will put out a container for donations. Joanne will confirm with Jill about holding the August meeting at Jill's new facility on 8/25.

Christmas Party: Camille advised that she has reserved the Fraternal Order of Police (FOP) facility on S. Orange Ave. for the party. This is a brand new facility; the cost will be \$500. The contract she has received from the FOP is very extensive, and asked Tom if he would review it. Because of their liquor license, we will have to use the FOP's bartender, but we can bring our own food.

Other Old Business: (1) Shirl reported she has done an article for the *GR News*. (2) The MFGRC ad for the National Specialty is finished, and Tom has sent the check to pay for the ad. (3) Tom also reported that the bill for the website has been resolved. (4) Shirl said she would work on response to the letter the Board received last month.

New Business:

Location for a future Match: Joanne suggested that we consider renting Jill's new training facility, saying why take chances with the weather when we can be inside with air conditioning. Debbie then suggested that if we are going to use Jill's place, then we should consider moving the Match to June, July, or August, since we always have difficulty finding ideas and places to hold monthly meetings during the hot months. This idea was well received.

2013 Specialty: Camille advised that it is getting "late" to start the planning process, finding a location, finding a chairperson, and hiring judges. We discussed what date we should consider. November in Brooksville was discussed – that would give us time to "regroup" after the Eastern Regional. Joanne suggested the Strawberry Cluster, where we could do all-breed obedience and rally (she has really good judges lined up), but that date (mid-February) is early in the year, and wouldn't allow for much planning time. There was much discussion as to whether we could get everything pulled together by February – we would need to start planning very soon. There was also discussion of whether to take a year off from having a specialty. We decided to revisit this topic at the next Board meeting in August.

The meeting was adjourned at 9:35 PM. Motion to adjourn was made by Shirl Phillips, and seconded by Joanne Hell.

I want to thank everyone for allowing me the privilege to work as your Puppy Referral Representative. Puppy Referral is like a 'Welcome Mat' to all that our club has to offer to prospective new members (puppy buyers). It allows us the opportunity to meet and educate the public while assisting in placing quality, healthy puppies into new homes.

Puppy Referral is a **tool** to help you, as a breeder, find good homes. There are no guarantees that the public will choose to buy a puppy from you simply because you list a litter on our club's website. In other words, it is not the club's responsibility to place a breeder's puppies. There have been questions recently regarding the way litters are listed, the length of time a litter is listed, etc. I would like to clear up a couple of those questions.

- #1) When people call me I <u>DO NOT</u> send them to a particular breeder or listing. Instead, I refer them to the website so that they can obtain the information for all of the litters listed at the time. If I have new litter information not yet up on the website, I will give that information to them as well.
- #2) Our webmaster places the listings as they come in. They are not listed in any particular order (i.e., date of birth, alphabetically, location, etc) Most puppy buyers look for puppies 'closest to home' first; how they are listed is of little importance.
- #3) The club has set a listing time limit of four months from date of birth. However, if a litter has been previously listed, a breeder has a puppy returned for any reason, that puppy is put back on referral at no charge. It may appear that the 'litter' has been listed for an extended period of time.

Over the past several months it became very clear that we needed to address some issues concerning the Puppy Referral program. As a result, our board has decided to make the following listing requirements:

New Puppy Referral Requirements for Mid-Florida Golden Retriever Club

- Must be a regular member in good standing during the previous 12 months
- Puppy referral listing will be limited to 4 months after litter whelp date
- Fee Schedule:
 - If member has attended 2 general club meetings <u>and</u> worked at 1 MFGRC sponsored event during the previous 12 months the fee is \$25.00*
 - If member has not attended 2 general club meetings <u>and</u> has not worked at 1 MFGRC sponsored event during the previous 12 months the fee is \$250.00

*It is the responsibility of the club member to notify the club secretary and the event chairperson to receive credit for these requirements.
