

DIRECTIONS TO ANN'S HOME (address is 23840 Oak Valley Lane, Sorrento, FL 32776):

From the South:

Take the Florida Turnpike North past the Turkey Lake Service Plaza. Follow sign for Apopka 429. Stay on429 and follow the signs to Mount Dora and Kelty Park Road. Right on Kelty Park Road then go left on Plymouth Sorrento until the road ends at Hwy 46. Turn right on Hwy 46 and at the next light go Left Hwy 437. At the next light take a Left onto Wolf Branch Road. Go 4/10 of a mile and take a Right onto Equestrian Trail. The next left is Oak Valley and Ann's driveway is on the Left. You can also pick up the 429 off of I-4 just past Hwy 27.

From I-4 North of Orlando:

Take the exit for the Seminole Mall (#101C) and turn onto Hwy. 46. Take 46 West toward Mt. Dora 15 miles to intersection with 437, at a stoplight. Turn RIGHT onto 437. Go 4/10ths of a mile on 437, and then turn LEFT onto Wolf Branch Rd. (there is no right turn here). Drive 4/10ths of a mile, where you'll see a street sign for Equestrian Trail on the RIGHT-turn in here. Equestrian Trail is a private road, so it's kind of narrow. Take the first LEFT on Equestrian-this is OAK Valley Lane. Ann's property is the first one on the left.

From Tampa/Lakeland:

Drive east on I-4 toward Orlando. You'll want the second exit after you pass the exit for Hwy. 27; this is the 429 toll road. Follow sign for Apopka 429. Stay on 429 and follow the signs to Mount Dora and Kelty Park Road. Right on Kelty Park Road then go left on Plymouth Sorrento until the road ends at Hwy 46. Turn right on Hwy 46 and at the next light go Left Hwy 437. At the next light take a Left onto Wolf Branch Road. Go 4/10 of a mile and take a Right onto Equestrian Trail. The next left is Oak Valley and Ann's driveway is on the Left. You can also pick up the 429 off of I-4 just past Hwy 27.

Eve's Gift

Reading With Third Graders Rewarding for Robin Burket and Eve

Once a week on her day off from work, Robin Burket and her Golden Retriever Eve head to Windermere (FL) Preparatory School.

At the school, Robin and Eve visit four different classrooms of third graders. As Robin and Eve sit, a small group of children sits in front of them and reads from books. The children read aloud and silently while also taking turns petting Eve, who sits calmly while the children's hands stroke through her soft fur.

Robin, who is a Neurosurgical Registered Nurse at Advent Health Orlando, spends a lot of time in the hospital with patients as part of her regular job. She's also a board member of the Mid-Florida Golden Retriever Club, with duties including chairing the club's June Specialty, handling membership applications and renewals, working at events and more.

But it's her time with Eve (Halia's Christmas In Killarney CCA CGC TKN THDN) at the school that provides Robin with some of her biggest rewards.

"I've been doing therapy work for almost a year now, and we've been reading with the kids since the beginning of the school year in September," she said.

Robin volunteers through her employer. The school has had the reading program going for more than a year but this year it expanded from just one dog to several and in multiple grade levels.

"I take small groups of kids and read with them apart from their classroom, like four kids at a time," she said. "They read a story to Eve and me and they get to pet her and sit with her while they're reading.

"They get excited about reading, they love seeing Eve and petting her, and it calms their anxieties," she said. "Or if they have any nerves about reading in front of the group, they're not really thinking about it because they're so excited about seeing Eve."

Robin and Eve were recently featured in a video posted online by AdventHealth, and the video was shared on the MFGRC Facebook group.

"It's really rewarding," she said. "Ever since I've had Goldens, particularly Eve, I know that she has a real gift for bringing people into her little world. She's very friendly and very calm and approachable. You see, especially with little kids, she has a really good attitude with them, so it's really great to see that she's doing something that she's really gifted at." ♥


Want to Volunteer for the 2020 GRCA National? Here's how . . .

The website for the 2020 Golden Retriever Club of America National Specialty, hosted by the Mid-Florida Golden Retriever Club, was recently launched.





2019 New Title Rosettes for MFGRC Members . . .

Members of the Mid-Florida Golden Retriever Club who earn new titles for their Goldens during calendar year 2019 may be eligible to receive a new title rosette from the club. The rosettes will be similar to this one from 2018 being modeled by Ralph and Maria Orlando's Golden boy Smokey:



This year a stipulation has been added to the process: in order to be eligible to receive a new title rosette from the club, a member must have volunteered to work for at least one club event during the year, or have done equivalent work for the club behind-the-scenes (subject to verification). The stipulation was added to encourage members to help with club events.

If your dog has won a new title in 2019 and you feel you are eligible to receive a rosette, please email the full name of the dog, what the title earned was and what event(s) you worked at to MFGRC board member Robin Burket. Robin will order the rosettes later this year and make them available for pickup early next year. If you will not be able to attend an event to pick up your rosette, you will be asked to send a check for \$10 for postage and handling, made out to MFGRC, so that it can be mailed to you.
