Mid-Florida Golden Retriever Club Board Meeting July 1, 2014

Board Members Present: Pat Kopco, Mike Orloff, Deena Strauss, Leah Wright, Dee Thibodeaux, Tom Young. The meeting was held via telephone conference call and called to order at 7:00 p.m.

President's Report: Pat Kopco had nothing to report.

Vice President's Report: Dee Thibodeaux reported that she has no new applications to present.

Secretary's Report: Motion was made by Mike Orloff to waive reading of the minutes and seconded by Dee Thibodeaux. The motion was carried. Leah reported that the AKC has sent out approvals for the agility trial via email.

Treasurer's Report: Debbie Finch was not present, however, she sent an email to the Board with the treasury information. The club does not publish club financial information on the internet.

Committee Report:

<u>Hunt Tests</u>: Judges are set, and Mike Orloff can answer any questions about who the judges will be. Mike is also getting the judges for the December hunt test for Tom Hell, and is working on that now. He would appreciate suggestions for master, junior, and senior. We currently need 2 more junior/senior judges and two more master judges. Discussion was held regarding travel expenses for the judges.

<u>WC/WCX</u>: Deb Farris was not present, but Pat reported that she assumes the WC/WCX is on track. Discussion was held regarding allowing curly-coated retrievers into the test if the judges do not object, even though they won't get a title.

<u>Tracking</u>: Pat is going to email the member who offered to take over as secretary of the tracking test to confirm her interest in doing so and to get an update on the land issues. Discussion was held regarding land that might be available in Dade City for the test.

Obedience Trial: Pat reported that she is assuming all is on track for the obedience trial August 9 and 10, 2014.

<u>Match</u>: Pat reported that she will not be able to be at the match July 6, 2014. We did not schedule a general meeting for that date due to the lack of board members who will be able to go since it is a holiday weekend and board members have other commitments.

<u>Agility Trailer Day Clean Out Day</u>: Pat reported when she returns from Canada she will talk to Camille about the trailer clean out day. The June dates did not work out for several reasons.

Agility Trial: Pat will request that Camille attend an upcoming board meeting to discuss equipment and volunteer needs.

<u>Holiday Party</u>: Pat reported that Caroline Roetzer has been in contact with the representative for the Eukanuba to get an update on the cost of having a holiday party and meeting after our specialty on December 12, 2014, at Eukanuba.

New Business:

There was no new business to discuss.

<u>Nominating Committee</u>: Tom Young reported that he has two other volunteers working with him on the nominating committee, and has talked to one club member about joining the board next year. Tom asked the current board members to email him letting him know if they will be returning next year.



It's Not Only About the Dogs

While most of us are familiar with the Morris Animal Foundation because of the <u>Golden Retriever Life-</u><u>time Study</u>, some might be surprised that the foundation has invested in over 2,000 studies that have improved the health and quality of life for wildlife globally.

Recently, on their website they posted information about saving the Javan rhinoceros from extinction. This is perhaps one of the most critically endangered large mammals. Estimates are there are only 35 to 50 of these magnificent animals left in the wild.

Through education of the indigenous people, research in infectious diseases affecting the rhino population, habitat conservation, and development of a vaccine program, the first steps have been taken to safeguard the Javan rhinoceros from extinction.



Puppy Referral

I want to thank everyone for allowing me the privilege to work as your Puppy Referral Representative. Puppy Referral is like a 'Welcome Mat' to all that our club has to offer to prospective new members (puppy buyers). It allows us the opportunity to meet and educate the public while assisting in placing quality, healthy puppies into new homes.

Puppy Referral is a **tool** to help you, as a breeder, find good homes. There are no guarantees that the public will choose to buy a puppy from you simply because you list a litter on our club's website. In other words, it is not the club's responsibility to place a breeder's puppies. Here are a few FAQs about the puppy referral process:

#1) When people call me I DO NOT send them to a particular breeder or listing. Instead, I refer them to the website so that they can obtain the information for all of the litters listed at the time. If I have new litter information not yet up on the website, I will give that information to them as well.

#2) Our webmaster places the listings as they come in. They are not listed in any particular order (i.e., date of birth, alphabetically, location, etc.) Most puppy buyers look for puppies 'closest to home' first; how they are listed is of little importance.

#3) The club has set a listing time limit of four months from date of birth. However, if a litter has been previously listed, a breeder has a puppy returned for any reason, that puppy is put back on referral at no charge. It may appear that the 'litter' has been listed for an extended period of time.

Over the past several months it became very clear that we needed to address some issues concerning the Puppy Referral program. As a result, our board has decided to make the following listing requirements:

Puppy Referral Requirements Mid-Florida Golden Retriever Club

- Must be a regular member in good standing during the previous 12 months
- Puppy referral listing will be limited to 4 months after litter whelp date
- Fee Schedule:

 If member has attended 2 general club meetings and worked at 1 MFGRC sponsored event during the previous 12 months the fee is \$25.00*

• If member has not attended 2 general club meetings and has not worked at 1 MFGRC sponsored event during the previous 12 months the fee is \$250.00

*It is the responsibility of the club member to notify the club secretary and the event chairperson to receive credit for these requirements.


