

Mid-Florida Golden Retriever Club Board Meeting May 6, 2014

Board Members Present: Pat Kopco, Mike Orloff, Deena Strauss, Leah Wright, Dee Thibodeaux, Deb Farris, Debbie Finch, Kristin Sipus, Laura Topping, Tom Young, Caroline Roetzer, and Sheree Melhuish. The meeting was held via telephone conference call and called to order at 7:00 p.m.

President's Report: Pat Kopco had nothing to report.

Vice President's Report: Dee Thibodeaux reported that she has one new member application for Erin Machek, but it does not list a sponsor. She has attempted to contact her, and Kristin Sipus has attempted to contact her as well.

Mike Orloff reported that he has changed the club membership application to reflect Dee's name and address because the ones on the website still have Joanne Hell's name on them. He will get in touch with Joanne to get the new application loaded on the website.

Secretary's Report: Motion was made by Mike Orloff to waive reading of the minutes and seconded by Deb Farris. The motion was carried.

Deena Strauss volunteered to send in the report to the AKC with the current officers and directors for the club.

Treasurer's Report: Debbie Finch gave the Treasurer's report. We do not publish this information on the internet.

Committee Reports:

<u>Specialty</u>: Caroline Roetzer reported she has hired two judges pending AKC approval. Discussion was held regarding judge expenses, the need to purchase trophies, and to get sponsors for the expenses. She has also hired Donofrio as the superintendent.

<u>February Hunt Test</u>: Mike Orloff reported that he is attempting to hire judges and would be glad for suggestions. He will be sending the application to the AKC this week. The dates for the test are February 7 and 8, 2014.

<u>December Hunt Test</u>: Mike Orloff will send Tom Hell an email asking for a status on the December hunt test.

<u>WC/WCX</u>: Deb Farris reported that the judges and event have been approved for our WC/WCX to be held September 27 and 28, 2014 in conjunction with the Florida Gold Coast club. It may be necessary to order ribbons. Mike Orloff has ordered the ducks.

<u>Obedience Trial</u>: No report. Deena Strauss reported that the AKC has sent approval letters for the trial. Mike Orloff will contact Joanne Hell for a status report.

December Hunt Test: No report.

<u>TD/TDX</u>: No report. Debbie Finch reported that there is a sign on the Lee Vista property that it is going to be developed in the near future, which will affect our TDX test. Discussion was held regarding land options. Tom Young reported that the property he had in mind will not be available.

<u>Agility Trial</u>: Pat Kopco reported that a club member had approached her last month about doing a dual agility trial with a local club. She also reported that another member from MFGRC spoke to the board of the other club and discouraged them about working with us on this, so their board has backed off the request. At this point we will not be moving forward with this.

Pat Kopco also reported that we have not signed a contract for a covered facility in south Florida because there was an issue with the one judge we had hired being able to judge there because he was already judging another trial in that area. Therefore, we will be returning to the Bill Frederick Turkey Lake Park for the agility trial in October and will continue to pursue other options for following years.

Camille Doehring has requested a volunteer day to clean out the agility trailer. Pat will ask Camille to coordinate this effort and to get volunteers and schedule the date.

New Business:

<u>DOCOF/DACOF</u>: Pat Kopco asked Leah Wright to send out an email to the membership asking if they are interested in captaining or participating in a DOCOF or DACOF team.

Nominating Committee: Discussion was held about the need to begin approaching members to serve on the nominating committee for 2015. Tom Young volunteered to head up the nominating committee and to recruit two other members to assist him. It was noted that the Nominating Committee will need to be in place in September, and must present a slate of officers to the Board at the October Board meeting. The slate of officers must be published to the membership by October 15, 2014.

<u>Bylaw Amendments</u>: Discussion was held regarding some proposed bylaw amendments. Pat Kopco will draft a set of recommended bylaw changes to present to the Board and then to present to the membership.

Old Business:.


<u>Fun Match</u>: Discussion was held regarding holding a fun match in 2014. Tom Young had volunteered to co-chair the match, and we had another member who was also considering volunteering. However, she has decided that she cannot do so if the match is held in Lakeland. Extensive discussion was held regarding what kind of match we want to hold and what our goals are for the fun match. Further discussion was held about the possibility of holding a fun match in November in conjunction with a general meeting.

<u>General Meetings</u>: Discussion was held regarding the next general meeting. We do not have anything planned for May or July. The June meeting will be held at the Tampa dog show on June 14, 2014. Our August meeting will be held August 9 at the obedience trial. The September meeting will be held at the WC/WCX on September 27, 2014 rather than at DOCOF. The October meeting will be held at the agility trial. The November meeting is usually held at the Ocala dog show grounds, but if we have a match in November we may hold the meeting there instead.

Next Meeting:

The next board meeting will be via telephone conference on Tuesday evening, June 3rd, 2014.

Adjournment: Sheree Melhuish made a motion to adjourn the meeting, and Deb Farris seconded the motion. The meeting was adjourned at 9:06 p.m.

The Morris Animal Foundation recently celebrated a milestone for its <u>Golden Retriever</u> <u>Lifetime Study</u> when Brooks, a playful pup was enrolled as the 1,500th participant.

Brooks' owner, Amy, had never owned a golden before, but felt motivated to enroll Brooks in the study: "Knowing that cancer is the leading cause of death in the breed, my husband I wanted to register Brooks as soon as he came home. This is such an amazing and impressive study, and we know it will help improve the lives of so many dogs."

Congratulations to Brooks and to Morris Animal Foundation on this milestone!

At the time of our newsletter's publication, the Foundation has enrolled 1,651 dogs.

Puppy Referral

I want to thank everyone for allowing me the privilege to work as your Puppy Referral Representative. Puppy Referral is like a 'Welcome Mat' to all that our club has to offer to prospective new members (puppy buyers). It allows us the opportunity to meet and educate the public while assisting in placing quality, healthy puppies into new homes.

Puppy Referral is a **tool** to help you, as a breeder, find good homes. There are no guarantees that the public will choose to buy a puppy from you simply because you list a litter on our club's website. In other words, it is not the club's responsibility to place a breeder's puppies. Here are a few FAQs about the puppy referral process:

- #1) When people call me I DO NOT send them to a particular breeder or listing. Instead, I refer them to the website so that they can obtain the information for all of the litters listed at the time. If I have new litter information not yet up on the website, I will give that information to them as well.
- #2) Our webmaster places the listings as they come in. They are not listed in any particular order (i.e., date of birth, alphabetically, location, etc.) Most puppy buyers look for puppies 'closest to home' first; how they are listed is of little importance.
- #3) The club has set a listing time limit of four months from date of birth. However, if a litter has been previously listed, a breeder has a puppy returned for any reason, that puppy is put back on referral at no charge. It may appear that the 'litter' has been listed for an extended period of time.

Over the past several months it became very clear that we needed to address some issues concerning the Puppy Referral program. As a result, our board has decided to make the following listing requirements:

Puppy Referral Requirements Mid-Florida Golden Retriever Club

- Must be a regular member in good standing during the previous 12 months
- Puppy referral listing will be limited to 4 months after litter whelp date
- · Fee Schedule:
 - If member has attended 2 general club meetings and worked at 1 MFGRC sponsored event during the previous 12 months the fee is \$25.00*
 - If member has not attended 2 general club meetings and has not worked at 1 MFGRC sponsored event during the previous 12 months the fee is \$250.00

*It is the responsibility of the club member to notify the club secretary and the event chairperson to receive credit for these requirements.

It's so bittersweet. Sunday, July 6, MFGRC had their annual AKC Sanctioned B Match. Zack won the June Kiernan Memorial Trophy which is awarded to the highest scoring Golden in the match. He was in the Veterans Obedience class. It was a thrill!

On Wednesday July 9, only 3 days later, we assisted Zack to the Rainbow Bridge and buried him overlooking a pond at a dog training friends property. He started to limp on Tuesday morning and couldn't put weight on his front left paw. We took him to a holistic vet who did acupuncture and laser treatment. He seemed to get worse as the day progressed.



Wednesday morning we took him to our regular Vet who took X-rays and found that cancer was destroying his ulna bone in his forearm and was in danger of a fracture.

We made the only decision we could, which was to put him out of his pain. He was known to steal bait bags and bumpers and hold 3 tennis balls in his mouth. He believed that all toys were his. As long time MFGRC member Sandy Guy said "A light has gone out in this world, but the next one just got a firework!". He was so loved and will be terribly missed. My first Golden and first dog I have owned as an adult.
