MFGRC would also like to thank the judges that give their time and knowledge to judge our hunt tests, club members and all the volunteers who work our hunts!!

Junior Handlers are very important to us at MFGRC. If you are working on a Junior Recognition Program sponsored by the AKC please see the Hunt Test Secretary for a Jr Handler Certification form prior to the HT. If you have questions about the program reference this link http://www.akc.org/kids_juniors/jr_recognition.cfm and to get an assigned JH number.

All dog handlers 17 years of age or younger are eligible for a 50% rebate of their entry fees for this AKC Hunt Test. To be eligible the handler must handle the dog in each series of the test or until they are eliminated from further participation by the judges. Each youth handler is limited to one rebate per stake entered. All must register as a "Youth Handler" with the Marshal for that stake at check-in. The rebate check will be either given to the youth or guardian, time permitting, by the hunt test secretary, or mailed within 2 weeks.

This property is a working cattle ranch; please close all gates and stay on road paths.

Remember: Consumption of alcoholic beverages on the test grounds is prohibited until the conclusion of the day's tests.

Test site and exercise areas will be marked. Exercise and airing outside of marked areas is forbidden. Violators will be immediately removed from the grounds. This is a private training ground that has generously been made available to the club, please help us to make sure we are welcome to return. Neither the Mid-Florida Golden Retriever Club, Inc., its officers, directors or members, or owners of the property are responsible for injury, damage, or theft occurring as a result of attendance or participation in this hunt test. Dogs and children must be kept under control at all times. This is a working cattle ranch. Please close all gates and stay on road paths.

Drawing

The electronic draw will take place at 01/30/2018 12:01 am Central Time and will be posted online available for viewing upon final approval by the Mid-Florida Golden Retriever Club.

Refunds

Entry Express handles scratches prior to the close.

To scratch before the close, handlers should email entries@entryexpress.net and include the dog's name, event, and stake or call (800)863-3647 or (501)255-0831.

After the draw, refunds will be given for bitches in season or for a dog withdrawn due to injury, illness or death. Request for a refund must be submitted to the Hunt Test Secretary prior to the beginning of the stake in which the dog is entered, and submission of an appropriate veterinary certification to the Hunt Test Secretary within one (1) week after the conclusion of the test.

If, after entering, a dog titles at the entered level and is "bumped up" into a higher stake the entry fee will be credited towards the higher stake.

Running Order

Running order will be posted on EE shortly after closing.

Dogs will be run in the order of the draw as fairly and expeditiously as possible. Handlers are responsible for having dogs available when they are called to run. Higher stakes take precedence. Please stay in touch with the marshals in your stakes.

All participants, judges, and workers shall be dressed in dark or customary hunting attire which adequately reflects a waterfowl or upland hunting situation. Spectators in the gallery should not wear white or light-colored clothing that might interfere with the tests.

Cell phones, beepers and pagers are not hunting equipment and have no place at the line or in the gallery. These have the potential to significantly disturb the working dog and handler. In the spirit of good sportsmanship, and in compliance with the AKC rules (Chapter 1 Section 24), please turn them off or leave them in your vehicle.

Directions

From Ocala & Northwest: Take I-75 South towards Tampa. Take FL Turnpike South. Take exit 289 to get on US 27 South. Drive 7.8 miles. Turn LEFT onto CR 561. Drive for 0.5 miles. Turn RIGHT on CR 561A. Drive for 3.2 miles. Turn RIGHT onto CR 455. Drive for approx. 1 mile to KATIES LANDING LANE. CFHRC HUNT TEST sign should be on road across from gate.
Intersection of Katie's Landing Lane and CR 455 Clermont FL 34715

From Orlando & Southeast: Take FL Turnpike to Exit 272 (SR 50). TURN LEFT (WEST) on SR 50, 1.3 miles to LAKE BLVD, Turn RIGHT on LAKE BLVD, then FIRST LEFT (0.2 miles) on to OLD COUNTY ROAD 50 (1.9 miles) which becomes COUNTY ROAD 455. Continue 3.3 miles into the town of Montverde, turning LEFT in the town center to stay on COUNTY ROAD 455 and continuing 1.8 miles to test Site at KATIES LANDING LANE on the left. CFHRC HUNT TEST sign will be on road across from gate.
Intersection of Katie's Landing Lane and CR 455 Clermont FL 34715.
