UNFINISHED BUSINESS:

Vote for donations

- Total Donation Amount: \$15,000
 - \$5,000 to Canine Cancer Research at the University of Florida College of Veterinary Medicine Jong Kim, DVM, PhD (Assistant Professor of Oncology) is working to identify new therapeutic target molecules in canine hemangiosarcoma. The goal is to develop more effective treatment based on the presence or absence of specific gene mutations.
 - \$5,000 to various canine cancer research studies at the University of Florida (College of Veterinary Medicine), including \$1500 to their cutaneous pythiosis research, \$1500 to the gastrointestinal pythiosis study, and \$2000 to mast cell tumor research. All of these diseases affect golden retrievers, and we hope to support UF research since most of our club members use them as the gold standard in Central Florida for emergency or advanced care when needed.

- \$2,000 to Golden Retriever Rescue of Mid Florida: "Our ongoing mission is saving, protecting, and rehoming golden retrievers, retriever breeds, and blends with golden hearts who have lost their home and families. We provide medical care, force-free behavior modification training, a home-based foster care environment, adoptions, and community education outreach programs. We are supported by an all-volunteer staff, donations, and foster homes."
- \$1,500 to Joshua's House Golden Retriever Rescue: "We are a dedicated group of dog lovers who find forever homes for stray, abused, or abandoned Golden Retrievers or Golden mixes. We have no age limit from birth to Hospice Care. We raise awareness to health care, spay, and neutering and to education of the community to adopting rather than Puppy mills or pet stores."
- \$1,500 \$500 to each of the three juniors in our club, who through their efforts and dedication, have achieved ranking within the top 10 Juniors according to Canine Chronicles.
- Discussion was around how the juniors would be awarded their prizes and it was stated that this will be cash for the 3 this year, but next year will be a new award that will be awarded as a savings bond. Also there was a discussion about the total amount donated based on what was made at the National in 2021. The money should be donated to help Golden Retrievers while the ones that helped bring in these dollars are still here to see this spent.
- Vote was taken 33 participated with 32 yes and 1 no for 97% yes
